The \$\$ and \$ are perfect for lunch breaks – almost all are close to the venue and serve nice-price menus at lunch time. The prices listed are only crude estimates and may vary between lunch and dinner.

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#### La Suite (Entrance and main dish: about 60 CHF)

With an attractive and a cosy decor, the restaurant la Suite seduces a very large public. The restaurant itself has 2 levels indoors and a roof terrace which is one of the most beautiful terraces in Lausanne. They specialise in continental food with an Asiatic touch.
