

Preliminary information on KBS 2009
35rd Annual Alcohol Epidemiology Symposium of the Kettil Bruun Society for Social and Epidemiological Research on Alcohol, Copenhagen, Denmark.

The local Danish organizing committee is very pleased to announce progress in organizing the 35th Symposium in Copenhagen 2009. The symposium is scheduled for 1. - 5. June 2009. The Central City Campus (of Copenhagen University and other institutions), which is located in the heart of Copenhagen, will serve as the venue. City campus is situated within walking distance of beautiful old Copenhagen, the harbour, City Hall and the walking streets. A variety of pre-meetings are scheduled to take place on the weekend before the symposium at Department of Sociology which are also part of City Campus.



We have chosen two medium-priced hotels as the central hotels for the conference. These are within 5 minutes walking distance of Central Campus. There will also be a number of cheaper hotels within a short distance of the venue. We plan the symposium so that it can be possible to explore Copenhagen while being at the conference. Lunch breaks can be enjoyed at the campus canteen or in some of the many nearby cafes and restaurants. The conference dinner will have to remain a surprise. But we can say that we have already booked the University ceremonial hall, which originally dates from 1536 and was rebuilt in 1829 after a fire destroyed central Copenhagen.
